BACK TO SCHOOL

The 2020-21 calendar can be found in Appendix A of the WLCSC Reopening Plan. Onsite and eLearning preferences are being collected at registration. WLCSC will be providing an eLearning/virtual option to parents who do not wish to send their child to school due to a qualifying medical event or due to a parent preference. eLearning will not replicate onsite instruction due to many factors. Parents will be expected to ensure that their child is following all of the online class requirements as directed by the online instructor.

ENHANCED CLEANING PROTOCOL

Safe & effective cleaning products will be used daily for all high touch areas in school, classroom, and on bus.

Sanitizing/disinfecting system using electrostatic sprayers was purchased in March 2020 for high traffic areas and buses.

Increased number of hand sanitizer stations are posted in key locations throughout all schools.

Intense cleaning occurring nightly including scheduled deep cleaning.

COVID-19 SYMPTOMS

Students experiencing COVID-19 symptoms must NOT be sent to school. Review **Appendix C** of the WLCSC Reopening Plan for a Self-Assessment Checklist that parents are encouraged to use daily prior to sending their child to school.

For guidance on when students experiencing COVID-19 symptoms can return to school, see **Appendix D** of the Reopening Plan.

COVID-19 POSITIVE PROTOCOL

INDIVIDUALS OR HOUSEHOLDS WITH POSITIVE COVID-19 RESULTS WILL BE QUARANTINED FOR 10 TO 14 CALENDAR DAYS BEFORE RETURNING TO SCHOOL.

HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOL



1 VISITORS

Schools will restrict visitors and guests into the buildings. All visitors will be required to wear a mask upon entering a WLCSC facility during the instructional day. There may be a medical reason that visitors cannot wear a mask.

2 TRAINING

Professional development will be provided for all staff and students/families on COVID-19 awareness, hygiene and sanitizing procedures, and self-screening measures.

3 HAND WASHING

A scheduled hand washing protocol has been established including longer passing periods and set times for handwashing. Additional hand sanitizer will be available at each school.

4 CLINIC

Each school will provide a separate clinic space to treat symptomatic students. Each school is staffed with a Registered Nurse to provide care to students.

5 COMMON AREAS

Procedures will be implemented for all breaks and common areas including bathroom breaks, recess, hallways, breakfast, lunch, and entering/leaving school to provide as much social distancing as possible.

6 SEATING CHARTS

Teachers will institute seating charts to assist the Tippecanoe County Health Department with contact tracing if necessary. Each student that rides the bus will have an assigned seat and masks will be required when riding the bus.

7 MASKS

Students in grades 3-12 will be required to wear a mask during the instructional day when social distancing is not possible. Students in grades K-2 will be required to have a mask with them at all times, and there will be times when the students will be required to wear their masks when social distancing is not possible. All employees will be required to wear a mask during the instructional day. In some cases, there may be a medical reason that students or staff cannot wear a mask.

8 STUDENT SUPPLIES

The administration requests that parents provide their children with a cloth mask, a filled water bottle, and hand sanitizer. If any family needs assistance with PPE, they should contact the school administrators. Following CDC guidelines, drinking fountains will be unavailable. Alternative contactless filling stations will be available.

9 PARENT EXPECTATIONS

Parents can partner with WLCSC by monitoring their child's health daily, reinforcing hygiene practices, and preparing their child for school each day.
