SUMMARY	The recent legislative session addressed the ambiguities surrounding curricular materials and fees. State code allows schools to charge reasonable fees for non-curricular supplemental items. These items are defined as: textbooks, workbooks, technology hardware and software. Items outside of this can now be charged as a fee to families. This change will allow the WLCSC to recoup revenue for expenditures that are not being covered by the current \$158/per student the state is currently passing through to districts through monthly tuition support for curricular materials.
