Important Notice to All Staff and Visitors

Please review the information below if you plan to attend (in-person) the special school board meeting on Wednesday, July 8, 2020 at West Lafayette Intermediate School. Self-screening is recommended according these guidelines for all attendees prior to arrival at the meeting. Visitors will park in the main lot and enter the building through Door #17.

Per Governor Holcomb's executive order 20-35 and 20-32, attendance will be limited to comply with social distancing guidelines.

Please do not enter the building if

- You have experienced a fever or COVID-19 related symptoms within the past 72 hours.
- You or anyone you have been in contact with has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 14 days.
- You have traveled internationally or to areas of the country with widespread ongoing community transmission within the last 14 days.

At this time, the CDC recommends

- Practicing social distancing of 6 feet from others
- Wearing a face covering over your mouth and nose in public areas to prevent transmission
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds
- Those at high-risk for severe illness from COVID-19 should exercise caution in public settings and limit contact with others as much as possible.
